SUA recognizes community service hours with an honor cord at graduation for seniors. Requirements for the graduating senior are as follows:

- ✓ Seniors must have completed 40 hours of accepted and performed community service hours while in grades 9 -12. It is **recommended** the student complete 10 hours per year, but not required.
- ✓ Accepted community service hours include the following, but not limited to: Participation in SUA school wide service projects, participation in service hours away from school assisting an organization for the benefit of others, an “thon” event that is conducted by an organization, and others to numerous to name( but must meet approval. )
- ✓ Church related hours are accepted (VBS, Mission/ Choir Trip); however, only 20 hours of church related service is allowed per year.
- ✓ Service hours must be turned in as soon as the student completes the activity (summer hours or hours completed during holiday periods must be completed and received in within a two week period after return date to school). All community service hour forms must be turned in to the Activities Director for documentation.
- ✓ All community service hour forms must be turned in to the Activities Director for documentation.

Community Service hours will be documented on the student RenWeb account.
