Senior Portraits 2018

ACT

SUA encourages all SENIORS to take the ACT, whether or not they plan to attend a higher educational institution after graduation, however it is not mandatory. A minimum score of 17 is needed to qualify for most local universities. It is recommended seniors take the October ACT their senior year. See back of brochure for ACT information.
