

## Alabama Driving Academy LLC

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Dear SUA Parents:

Thank you for your interest in the driver education program at Success Unlimited Academy and the partnership with Alabama Driving Academy, LLC. Drivers education is an essential component of every licensed driver's background; and with Alabama's Graduated License Law, completing a Driver Education course carries even more importance. With this law affecting all teens turning sixteen (16), Driver Education is listed as one of the requirements for obtaining a full and unrestricted Drivers License (in addition to maintaining six months of ticket and accident free driving). Our students learn that holding a driver's license is a privilege and not a right. They learn that driving is a responsibility not to be taken lightly and our staff counts on the support of the parents to help us impress this on the students. The program we offer consists of two phases.

**Phase I - Classroom studies (Refer to the class schedules attached)** We will study traffic laws, defensive driving techniques, DUI, automobile maintenance, use of safety belts, and the deadly distraction of cell phone/texting. This is accomplished through the use of lectures, films and a variety of other classroom activities. Also included in classroom studies is a comprehensive Alabama Boating Basics Curriculum. All motorized boat owners must be certified by the State of Alabama. Anyone age thirteen (13) and over must have this license to legally operate a boat on Alabama's waterways. SUA Driver's Education will be held at the Fairlane Campus. Students must attend both sessions in order to receive credit for the class. The class is an elective on the cum card (1 credit) at SUA. Both phases (Phase I and II) MUST be completed to receive your certificate. Students are to bring a pencil or pen to class.

**Phase II - Behind-the-wheel driving sessions (Will be scheduled with the driving instructor)** This training is done at the student's convenience. When possible, we strongly recommend that this training take place within the first three months of the student's driving experience. This appears to be the time in which the student is more attentive and ensures that the student learns the proper driving methods from the beginning; it also helps prevent the development of poor driving habits. Behind-the-wheel training is usually conducted in three sessions lasting between one hour to one hour and ten minutes.

**The cost is \$200 and MUST be paid by the first day of class.** Attached you will find a schedule and registration form for our 2022-2023 classes. Please fill out the attached registration form and return as soon as possible, along with your payment to Mrs. Rambo at the front desk ( Fairlane Campus. )
